

The Wianno Sailing Foundation is a tax-exempt 501(c)(3) public charity that promotes sailing education and supports recreational and competitive sailing on the Cape and Islands. In 2014, the Foundation purchased the property at 101 Bridge Street, and leased it to the Wianno Yacht Club. In lieu of rent payments, WYC operates the Junior Sailing Program on behalf of the Foundation. In addition to acting as a benevolent landlord for WYC, the Foundation supports other sailing programs in a variety of creative ways. We rely on the support of donors to advance our mission.

This iconic sailboat is used in the Junior and Adult sailing program and is available for use by other sailing programs on the Cape.
